

Kent and Yvonne Shafer adopted the famous Mr. Blue to be brother to the wonderful Jake and Earl.



Tribute to my Baby, Auntie Em.

Well, she's gone and I can't believe it. That horrible osteosarcoma took her so fast I hardly had a chance to breathe. She was quite a girl and I'd like to tell you a little about the foster who never left.

Auntie knew all my greyhounds to date. I fostered her when I had Cookie, my first greyhound adopted in 1989, and Rocket. Then they died and along came Max, Thunder, Redd and Mollie -- and Auntie lived happily with them all. Her track name was Auntie Em and it suited her so I kept it.



From the beginning, she was a high spirited girl—running through the house with my shoes so fast I didn't even know they were missing, her tail doing that whirly-gig thing instead of wagging side to side -- her tail always went around in circles! She was bright, she was a little flighty and she was her own

delightful girl. She welcomed any doggie or person into the house with pleasure and kisses which she liked to give freely. As she got to know you, she'd also give hugs, putting her head on your shoulder for some lovin'.

As she aged, she stayed the same delightful girl and was healthy until that fateful limp started. We managed the pain for a few months and then we both knew the end was near. AS SEEN ON TV

I'm a sucker for TV ads. Especially if they make unbelievable claims. Well I fell for the one advertising the PETICURE. The miracle pet nail trimmer that will save you time, money and stress. I went to their website and watched the videos. Sure looked easy enough. You could by the whole tool for a little over 50 bucks or just the plastic head. I already had the cordless



dremel that they recommended so I purchased the plastic screw on head with the different sized holes for different sized nails. \$20 dollars wasn't too bad...But would it pass the JoeJohn test? I attached the head and adjusted the hole to fit the tip of the nail. This provides a fulcrum point for the nail and reduces vibration... I snuck up on Rudy and let him sniff it..seems harmless enough.. Held his toe and turned it on....It worked! He stayed down and let me do all of his nails. JJ

would be the real test. At the vets we always had to muzzle Joe John and hold him down to trim his nails. I caught him laying down on his favorite couch. I rubbed his foot while he sniffed it. Holding onto his toe I placed his nail in the hole and it worked! He pulled his paw away but was still laying down. I trimmed another nail and walked away for awhile. [] stresses too easily. My strategy would be a few nails at a time. 2 days later both dogs had trimmed nails and I had paid off my purchase within the first 48 hours. It turns out the different sized holes for different sized nails sets the Peticure apart from the other. The head also catches most of the nail dust. It didn't hurt to have the powerful dremel either. Some of the competing nail trimmers use AA or C batteries. Definitely not enough power. Would this work for your dogs? I don't know but considering how much money you could save you may want to consider it. If you would like to check it out I may bring it to the spring picnic..... KM
